

WEEKLY MARKET PRICE 16-2024

- Cotton futures have plunged in the last week in New York, eventually returning to their levels from three months ago.
- The PTA price has been volatile in the past week before returning to its initial level. Meanwhile, MEG prices remain firm.
- Cotton fiber and yarn prices have declined in the last week in India.
- Textile fiber prices have fallen in the last seven days in China, reflecting the weak demand level.
- Over the past week in Pakistan, cotton yarn prices remained stable during the slow business period of the Eid holidays. Cotton fiber prices stayed consistent with limited stocks available, and the benchmark KCA rate unchanged.
- Polyester spun yarn prices have fallen over the last week in China, India, and Turkey, when measured in US dollars, while remaining unchanged in Bangladesh and Pakistan.
